PREPARING FOR FLU SEASON

Town Hall Meeting - Preparing for the Flu We felt incredibly fortunate to have the expertise of our panel to help us understand the particulars of this early flu season. Physicians, Mitch Katz, Director of SF Public Health, Brinda Emu and Sunil Parikh, infectious disease experts, presented the parents with practical and reassuring information regarding the seasonal flu and H1N1. Here are some of the most important facts:

- H1N1 is no more serious than seasonal flu (seasonal flu season usually begins in January but H1N1 is peaking now)
- The increase in cases of H1N1 now make it impossible to prevent, so quarantine is no longer effective.
- Out of 1000 people, 999 will be okay. The one/1000, statistically may be a child (4 or younger or a pregnant woman in 1st or 2nd trimester.

Precautions:

- Get vaccinated
- Stay home when ill. Keep children home when they have a fever. Children and adults must be feverfree, without fever reducing medicine, for 24 hours before returning to school. Be prepared to pick up your child from school if they are ill.
- Wash hands often, or use alcohol-based sanitizers.
- Fresh air and sunlight keep windows/doors open and air out the house.

By vaccinating children, you may prevent them from getting the flu and help protect others. H1N1 vaccine is now available at many locations and is reserved for highrisk groups including: people 6 months-24 years of age, pregnant women and adults with medical conditions. To schedule a vaccine, call your physician or see the flyer in the Sunrooms that gives information about the Public Health H1N1 vaccination sites held throughout the city October 29-October 31.
